

Golf Course Committee

Summary of Meeting July 12, 1971

It was reported the Park and Recreation Commission had voted to request the town to purchase 50 acres of additional land adjoining the golf course site.

Judge Reed Shields accepted a position on the committee and was in attendance at the meeting.

It was reported that a letter had been received from Al Radko of the USGA Green Section with regard to contacting architects but that little information resulted.

The committee decided to write directly to George Fazio with regard to the architecture of the course. It was noted, however, this is to be an initial contact to determine procedures and not to be construed that Mr. Fazio will definitely be the architect.

Judge Shields agreed to investigate the procedures for revenue bond financing and make a report to the committee at its next meeting.
