Dear Fred:

I have at hand a copy of a letter from Cahill to you with regard to the electricy at the golf course site. Further, I understand from Gino and Reed that you think this cost is entirely too high and that a savings might be realized by installation of our own generator.

I share your opinion and would like to ask that you investigate as thoroughly as possible the installation of our own generator and make a report to the committee at our next meeting on July 10. Bear in mind, however, I think that Nemo wants electricity at the site as soon as we can arrange for it. I also know we will need to have it hooked up to the irrigation system approximately the middle of August, assuming weather and construction allow it.

Therefore, it seems to me this is a matter of expediency.
