Re: Electric Power

It is my understanding that our needs for electricity are soon going to be critical. If work continues as it has in the past two weeks without mechanical failure or bad weather, Nemo expects to begin seeding on some greens and tees by the third week in August. He has already said he will probably seed whether or not we are able to pump water. Naturally this is not preferable.

Joe McLinden has suggested that we approach Connecticut Light & Power with the idea of bringing our electric needs in from Ridgebury Road adjacent to our entrance and take it underground from there along the 9th fairway and to our pump station site.

The other avenue, of course, is our own generator.

It seems to me we should have a meeting immediately with Connecticut Light & Power and Joe McLinden at the site with the contractor and settle this matter as soon as possible. I have approached Nemo with the idea of him providing us with a trench for the electric conduit which he is willing to do but he needs the specifications from the power company before he can give us a price.

Please advise.
