Dear Fred:

The costs to provide electrical service to the Municipal Golf Course will remain the same as we determined in November of last year.

The enclosed sketch shows the anticipated route to provide power to the clubhouse, the storage barn, and the water pumps. The total cost to you would be \$5,728.00 for the cable and its installation. The cost for service to the clubhouse alone would be \$2,070.00.

In addition, your contractor would be required to provide all trenching and backfilling, the secondary wiring, the concrete pads for the transformers, and any conduit necessary at the pads and along the service route.

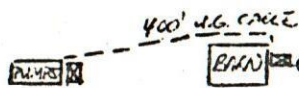
We would appreciate having a breakdown of all electrical loads as soon as possible so we are able to order necessary materials. If I can provide any assistance or information, please contact me at any time.

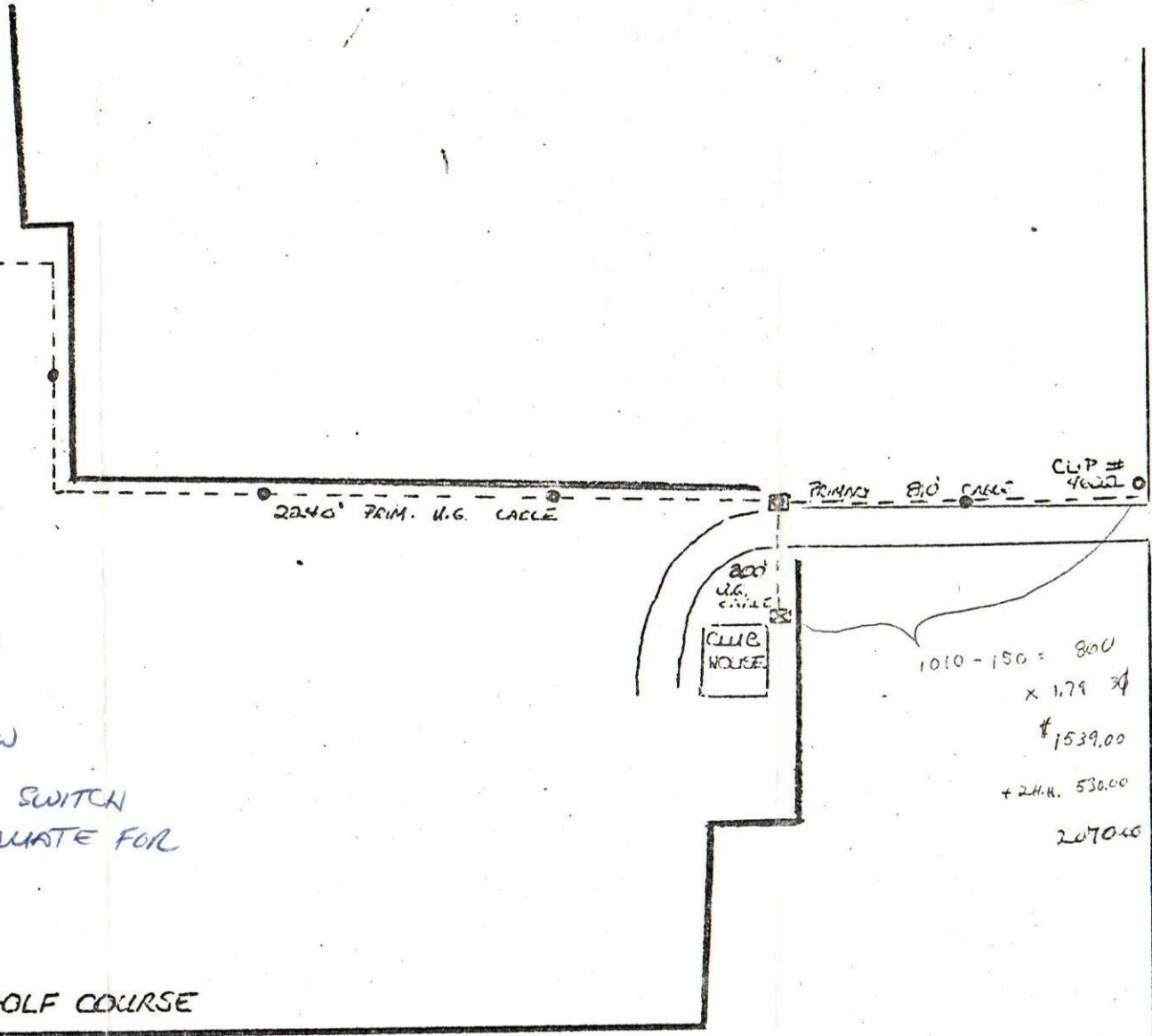
